

STATEMENT

To develop musical talent for inner city youth, one child at a time.

GOAL

Our goal is to equip inner city youth with basic and fundamental knowledge of music theory and primary skills and techniques for the piano and violin.

CURRICULUM Music Instruction

1) **Keyboard:** Each session will be **45 minutes**. The first 15 minutes will consist of students learning theory, the remainder 30 minute will be keyboard instruction. Our goal is for each child to posses' basic knowledge and musical theory, as well as read selected beginners' repertoire with ease and confidence. Piano lessons consist of no more than 10 students per lesson. Group lessons are offered only at *beginners' levels*. Students attending Riverton Street Charter School only can take lessons, unless an arrangement is made. It is **\$37 per lesson**.

PAYMENTS

Payment Due Dates / Late Payment and Service Fees Payments. Payment is due the 1st week of each month or when the invoice is received. A registration form must be completed and submitted digitally or handed in person, or via mail. A registration fee of \$25.00 per student is required at the time of enrollment along with the tuition for the first month. Late payments are subject to a \$10 late payment fee.

Registration

Registration forms are sent electronically and must be filled out in its entirety.

WITHDRAWAL

A student who wishes to withdraw after lessons begin must submit written notice to instructor **two** weeks prior. Informing a teacher of intent to withdraw does not constitute adequate notice. New Era Music will issue a refund for any lessons remaining. There will be a \$37 withdrawal fee if the required two-week notification is not provided. Please allow three to four weeks for the processing of refunds.

Attendance

Students must attend scheduled lessons, arrive on time, and bring their music material..

There will be no make up sessions for students who come late or is absent without 24hr verbal or written communication. As a courtesy, students are asked to call 1-862-378-0960 at least 24 hours prior to any scheduled absence. In cases of emergencies,

students are asked to contact New Era as soon as possible to ensure that the instructor is informed in a timely manner.

Release

Dismissal
